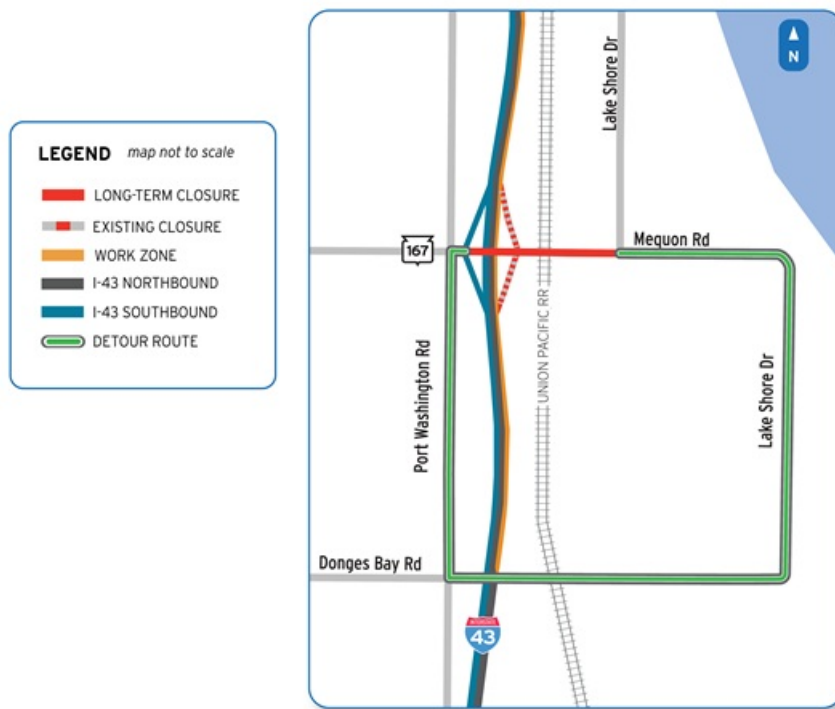

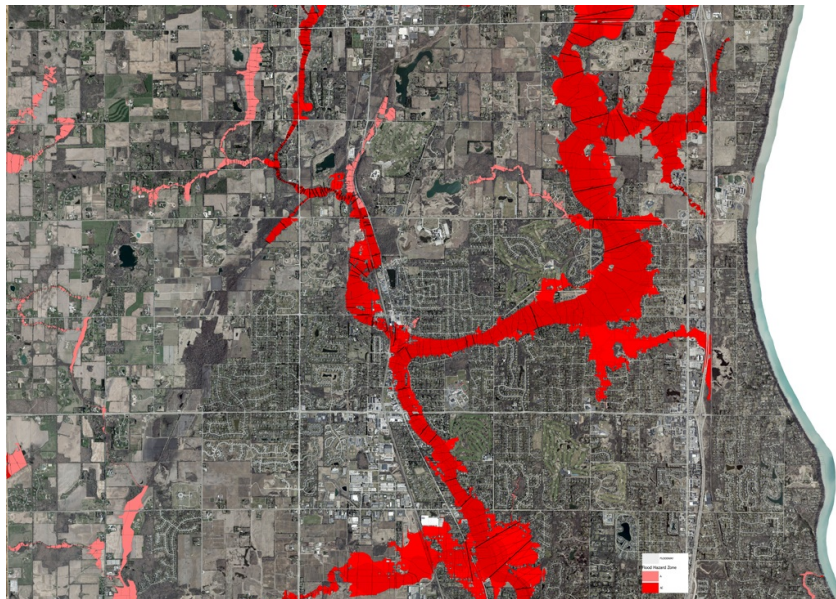
Mequon Road to Close Long-Term Starting June 3

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing work on the 14-mile, I-43 North-South reconstruction project between Silver Spring Drive and WIS 60 (Washington Street), in Milwaukee and Ozaukee counties. As part of the Mequon Road Interchange Segment, Mequon Road, between the I-43 southbound ramps and Lake Shore Drive, is scheduled to close to traffic long-term (approximately two months) for roadway reconstruction beginning Monday, June 3, by 6:00 a.m. During this time, access to and from the I-43 southbound ramps will be maintained from the west. Motorists are encouraged to use Port Washington Road, Dongs Bay Road, Lake Shore Drive, and Mequon Road to get around this closure. Access to all businesses and residences will also be maintained.

Floodplain Maps & Ordinance Open House This Wednesday



City staff will host an Open House at City Hall on Wednesday, May 29, from 9:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. related to new floodplain maps and a model ordinance developed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Wisconsin Department of Natural

Resources (WDNR), respectively. The adoption of the maps and model ordinance is required by the DNR and FEMA in order for the City to remain a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program. Based on a comparison to the previously adopted 2007 maps, the base flood elevation has changed. Those residents whose property may be impacted were mailed a postcard on May 3, and are encouraged to attend the Open House to learn more. The 2024 maps can be viewed [here](#). 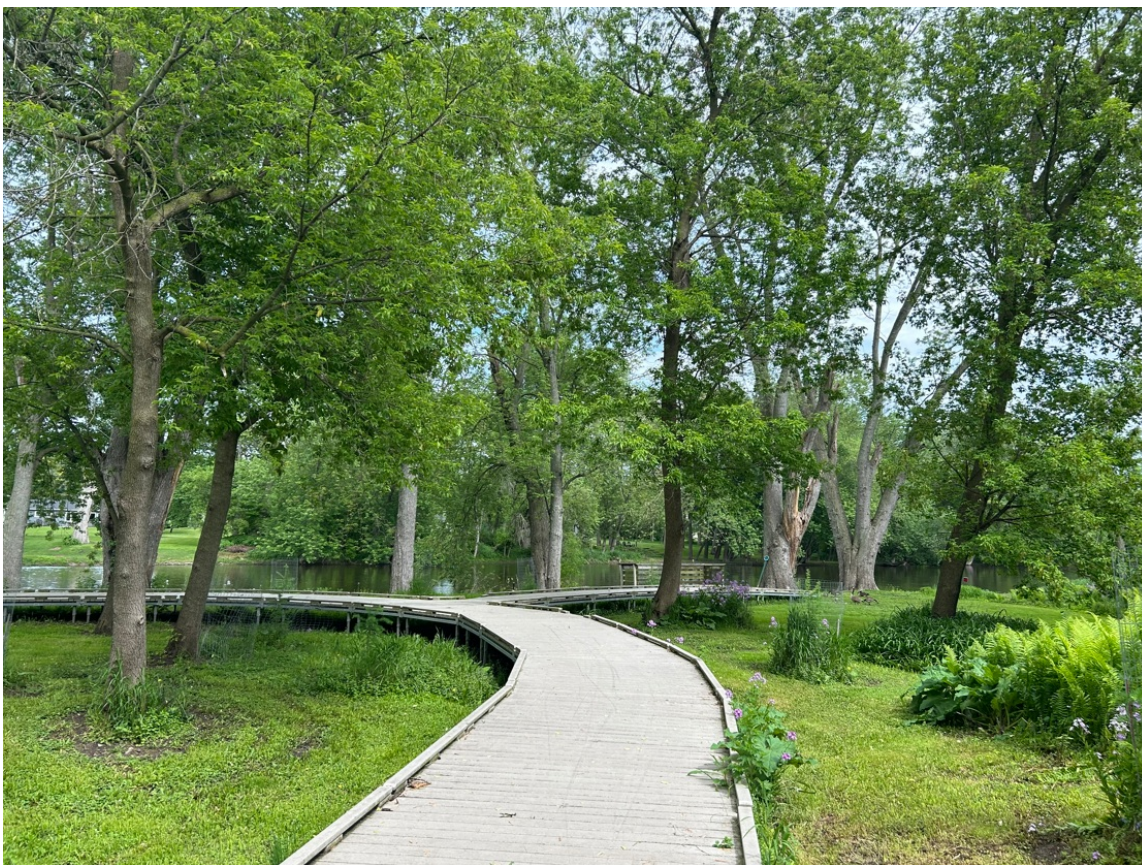
